Our Diverse Community



The Jewish Federation of Greater Dallas is a reflection of a rich and diverse cultural community that is a vital part of the DFW population. Our impact reaches the Jewish community and beyond; while there are many common misconceptions on the status of faith in our institution, Federation is a nonsectarian organization and does not maintain a religious affiliation. Many agencies we support service people regardless of religious or political alignments. Jewish Family Services, one of our long-standing community partners, provides life-changing programs, such as a food pantry, counseling, and other services, to over 39,000 people, 85% of which are not Jewish. What We Do





Community Convener

As a trusted Dallas nonprofit, we inspire and engage the community through various services and programs that position us as the primary convener for the Dallas Jewish community. We partner with local universities, schools, government agencies, and other organizations to strengthen our support of the community and further establish our ability to bring people together to connect, learn, and grow.



Security

Staffed by a full-time Director of Community Security and Deputy Director of Security, the department is charged with convening, preparing, and equipping organizations with training and education, emergency communications, law enforcement engagement, and target hardening.



Community Investment

Powered by your generosity, we strategically invest millions of dollars into our community and beyond through programming, services, and fiscal support for organizations such as Jewish Family Services and Ann & Nate Levine Academy. Federation partners with government and interfaith organizations to protect, educate, and serve the community and foster meaningful connections and conversations.

Providing Services



Federation not only funds life-changing and life-sustaining initiatives throughout the community via 85+ partner agencies, but provides educational services. The Center for Jewish Education (CJE) provides programs to support both early childhood education and teachers throughout the community. PJ Library sends free Jewish children's books to families across the world every month helping connect children and their parents with their Jewish heritage. The CJE partners with local universities, professionals and our own Jewish educators to offer cutting edge courses that include both content and teaching methods.

Responding to Crisis



As a strong community convener, we are positioned to provide support to local, national, and international communities after natural disasters and emergency situations. This past year has been tumultuous and has brought many challenges to the community. We have provided not only millions of dollars in support, but many opportunities to come together to connect and grieve the atrocities of war including the recent October 7th, Community Commemorative Event with over 1,700 attendees


Why Support Us

Combat Rising Antisemitism

Antisemitic incidents have increased 140% compared to 2022 with over 7,500 of these incidents occurring after the atrocities of October 7th, 2023 (ADL, 2024). As one of the most trusted and respected nonprofits in Dallas, JFGD partners with local and national intelligence agencies to monitor and respond to potential threats in the community. 

With your support, we can continue to provide programming, education, community events, and invest in local organizations to help enhance not only the Jewish but the diverse Dallas community.


